ITINERARY

Day 1: Wednesday - Longreach

Arrive in Longreach for the start of your Outback Queensland adventure. Day 2: Thursday - Longreach

Join our Strathmore Station Tour for an insider's view into life on the land followed by a delicious home-baked morning tea. Day 3: Friday – Longreach

Witness a totally different way of schooling on a tour of the Longreach School of Distance Education. Day 4: Saturday – Winton

Travel west to Winton and learn the story behind Australia's unofficial national anthem at the Waltzing Matilda Centre; the only museum dedicated to a song. Check-in to your accommodation for the next two nights then enjoy some free time in downtown Winton. Day 5: Sunday – Winton
