### **Day 1 Sydney - Hanoi**

### **Day 5 Hoi An**

### **Day 7 Hoi An-Ho Chi Minh City**

Today we fly to Ho Chi Min City; once we arrive we have free time to explore before we enjoy our dinner on a Saigon River Dinner cruise, while it sails along Saigon River.

### **Day 8 Ho Chi Min City**

This morning, we head to the famous Cu Chi tunnels. The tunnel complex was initially constructed in 1948 to protect the Viet Cong guerrillas from French air and ground sweeps and also served as communication routes, storage facilities for food and weapon caches as well as hospitals and living quarters for guerrilla fighters throughout the Vietnam War. Lunch is at Local Restaurant. After

lunch continue Saigon city tour in the afternoon which includes Reunification Palace to have a glimpse into the lifestyle of the democratic regime of former South Vietnam. Next we walk to the Post Office with its impressive Renaissance, Colonial & Gothic architecture style. Visit Dong Khoi street (Rue Catinat) and War Remnants Museum. Finish your day at Ben Thanh market, the biggest market in town.

### **Day 9 Ho Chi Minh City**

Day trip to Cai Be to see the agrarian life in vibrant Southern Delta. Visit a floating market where people from around the area gathering to sell fruits and their home-made products on the sampans. Continue to the local industrial workshops producing rice paper & coconut candy, and a fruit orchard to taste the special fruit here. Depends on the water level, you will visit an ancient house with combination of French Colonial and Traditional Vietnamese fusion – or walk to a local house to catch a glimpse of the daily life. Enjoy fruits and tea while listening to traditional music. Head back to Ho Chi Minh City Hotel in the afternoon. Rest of the day is free at leisure, for you to do some last-minute shopping, pampering or simply enjoying the hotel facilities.

### **Day 12 Siem Reap**

Today take the early morning trip to enjoy stunning sunrise of Angkor Wat, you also have the chance for a friendly talk with the monks and nuns at a nearby pagoda. We visit some local villages on the way to Banteay Srei Temples. Have lunch at a local restaurant for exotic cuisine. Ta Prohm temple and Takeo Temple are your next stops before some leisure time in the late afternoon. This evening we enjoy dinner at Por Cuisine, which is a Khmer fusion

fine dining experience with its own daily traditional Apsara dance performance.

**Day 13 Siem Reap-Phnom Penh**
